Nazareth Housing is pleased to announce the receipt of a \$15,000 grant from the Lily Auchincloss Foundation supporting client services coordination of the organization's highly acclaimed homelessness prevention programming, part of the Housing Stability and Support Project (HSSP). Prevention programs are available to Nazareth Housing's clients and families in the community.

At the core of our work with families and their children is intensive case management and well-developed programs that help them acquire greater self-sufficiency and enhanced skills. Programs for children and youth coordinate with our adult programming to encourage families to work together to rebuild their lives, while minimizing the trauma caused by housing instability. In 2011, HSSP provided services to over 2400 households and more than 4300 individuals.

Nazareth Housing is a 501(c)(3), not-for-profit, non-sectarian organization with a long and proud history of innovation and advocacy. Nazareth Housing was founded in 1983 as a pioneer in the development of scattered-site emergency family shelter for homeless families. For the past six years, NH has been named one of the top performing family shelters among the NYC Department of Homeless Services shelter providers, and has served over 10,500 unduplicated households since 2006.
